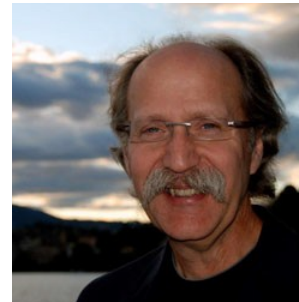
AT THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Stephen H. Linder, Ph.D., is a Distinguished Teaching Professor in Management, Policy and Community Health and Director of the Institute for Health Policy at the UT School of Public Health. He was the Chancellor's Health Fellow in Public Health for 2014.

He completed his doctoral degree in Political Science at the University of Iowa and served on the faculties of UCLA and Tulane before coming to UT in 1984. He was elected to the Kenneth I. Shine Academy for Health Science Education in 2013 and has won School, UT System, and State-wide teaching awards.

Dr. Linder is currently PI on three projects: the Health of Houston Survey and Research Into Action, funded by private foundations, and Cumulative Risk Assessment supported by the US EPA. His current research interests include: integrated health needs assessment, mechanisms of cumulative risk, and the interface between health risk and environmental sustainability.
