

Entrance Exam Waivers and Exemptions

In some circumstances, your requirement to submit GRE, MCAT or GMAT scores may be waived if below criteria is met.

GRE/MCAT/GMAT scores may be waived if the applicant:

- holds an earned doctoral letter degree from a U.S. institution
- is an ECFMG certified physician practicing medicine in the U.S. (i.e. active in a medical residency program or clinical practice)

Previous UTHealth School of Public Health students may waive the GRE/MCAT/GMAT if the applicant:

- Previous UTHealth School of Public Health General Public Health Certificate students completing all five of the six core courses that are applying to the Master of Public Health (MPH) program with a Cumulative UTHealth SPH GPA of 3.4+
- Previous UTHealth School of Public Health graduate from the Master's (MS or MPH) program with a Cumulative UTHealth SPH GPA of 3.4+ applying to a doctoral program.
