Dr. Colón López is the Puerto Rico Coleader of The University of Puerto Rico and The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center Partnership for Excellence in Cancer Research Outreach Core. She is also a professor at the University of Puerto Rico, Medical Sciences and Campus. Researcher at the University of Puerto Rico Comprehensive Cancer Center. She completed a doctorate in epidemiology from the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor.

During the past decade, Dr. Colón has worked in research areas such as epidemiology of the Human Papilloma Virus (HPV), HIV and health disparities in cancer and infections, mainly in vulnerable populations. She leads the Puerto Rico Outreach Program, as well as the Data Analysis and Publication Core (DAPuC) and the HPV-PIVac (HPV Policy Implementation Vaccination) research projects. Dr. Colón-López has written several scientific publications on the subject of HPV, HIV, and sexually transmitted diseases in vulnerable populations.
