

WHICH COVID-19 TEST SHOULD I TAKE?

START HERE

"I live or work closely with someone who has COVID-19."
"I need to get tested for work or because I'm traveling."

Most Accurate Results!



Get the **Diagnostic (PCR) Test**. A thin swab is inserted into your nose or throat.

Wait **2 to 5 days** for results to see if you have COVID-19.

"I feel sick!"



Get the **Antigen (Rapid) Test**. A thin swab is inserted into your nose or throat.

Wait **15 minutes** for results to see if you have COVID-19.

"I feel fine..."
But I want to know if I ever had COVID-19."



Get the **Antibody (Serology) Test**, where a needle is used to get a small blood sample.

Wait **3 to 5 days** for results to see if you have COVID-19 antibodies from a past infection.

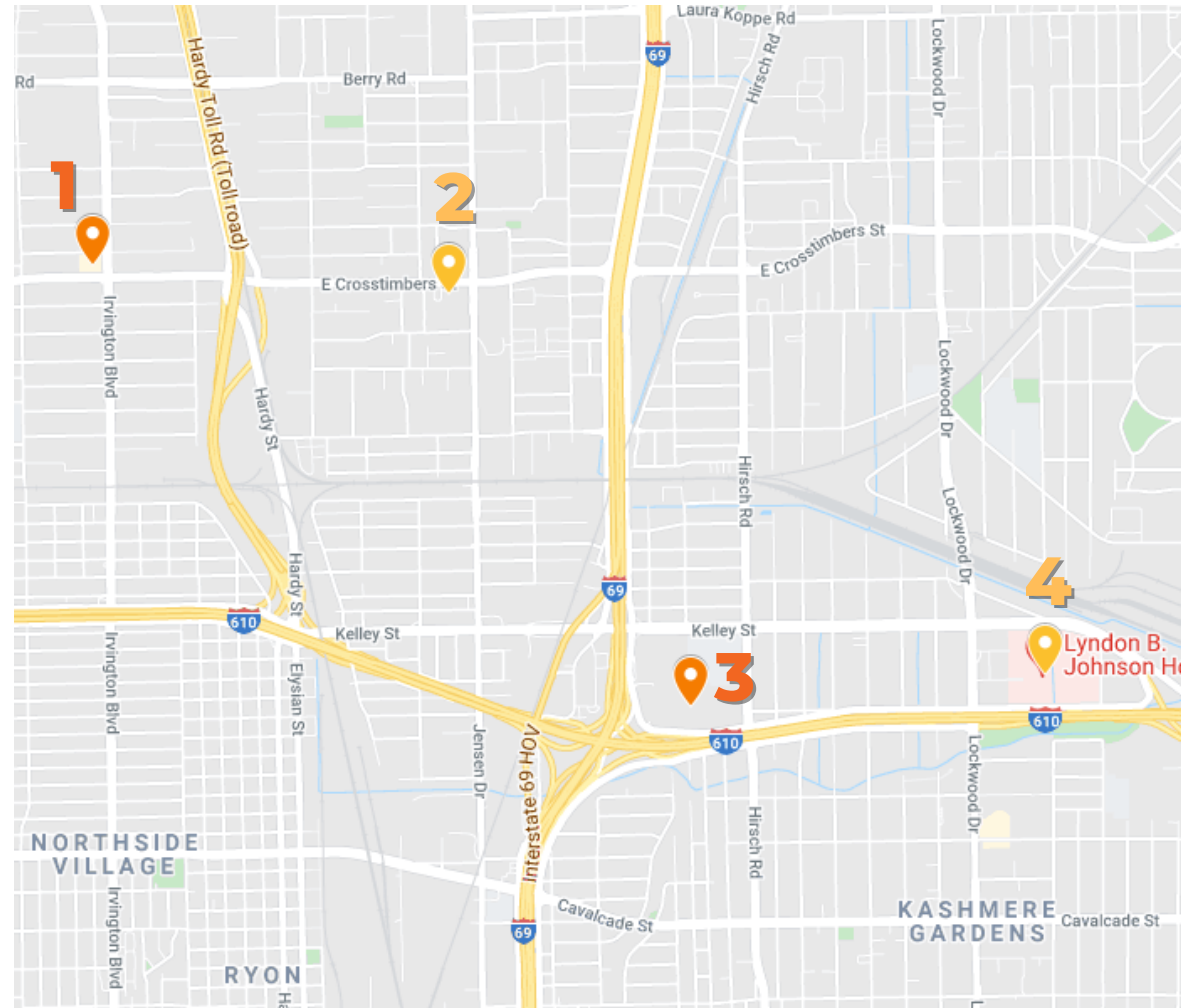
