# CATCH in Los Fresnos CISD: How do we know it's working?





#### **About Los Fresnos CISD**

- 7,500 students in 9 elementary and 3 middle schools
- 97% of students are Hispanic
- 76% of students are FRL eligible







#### **About Los Fresnos CISD**

- FitnessGram: LFCISD students are more likely to be overweight or to have low cardiovascular fitness compared to the rest of Texas
- Small exposure to CATCH 10 years ago
- Greater district and community support for coordinated school health made this a good time to try again





## Why CATCH?

- State CSH mandate
- CATCH is evidence-based
  - Reduces overweight and obesity
  - Produces lasting changes in diet and physical activity
- Addresses the entire educational environment
  - Classroom, physical education, food services, and family





## Why CATCH?

Because students who eat right and are physically active have ...

- Better Academic Performance
  - Class grades, standardized test scores, graduation rates
- Better Education Behavior
  - Attendance, drop-out rates, behavioral problems
- Better Cognitive Skills
  - Concentration, Memory





## **Getting Started**

- Securing district-level approvals
- Building support among school principals
- Managing start-up costs
  - Partnered with CATCH Global Foundation
  - Awarded a 1-year grant from BlueCross BlueShield of TX to implement CATCH in all 12 elementary and middle schools





### Administrator Support

- Develop an understanding amongst all stakeholders
- Promoting the program
  - Individualized department/cluster awareness meetings
- Meetings with champions
- Staff development
- Community partnerships for wellness events





















#### Increase in MVPA during PE Classes




Overall, a 29% increase in physical activity level






#### Middle School PE Classes
