

English Literacy Test (with instructions in English)
Wide Range Achievement Test 3 Reading – Shortened (WRAT3R-S-E)

Examiner: Ask the participant to “Read the letters and words from this card in English. Speak in a loud and clear voice.” and prompt with: “What letter (word) is this in English?” For words: “Read each word out loud, but don’t worry about what the words mean.” Use these prompts as needed to encourage the participants to respond (in English). Point to letters and words on the card as needed.
