## **Muscle Cells**

Pioglitazone (Actos)

• Makes muscle cells more sensitive to the insulin

#### Liver

Metformin (Glucophage)

• Slows glucose release from liver

## **Liver and Pancreas**

Sitagliptin (Januvia)

 Helps balance insulin levels between the liver and the pancreas

## **Pancreas**

Repaglinide (Prandin), Glyburide (Diabeta, Micronase), Glipizide (Glucotrol), Glimepride (Amaryl)

 Helps pancreas release more insulin

### Insulin

 Used when your pancreas cannot make enough insulin

### Intestines

Acarbose (Precose, Glyset)

 Slows breakdown of food

Generic is listed first, followed by brand name in parenthesis.
