



SWCOEH Post Harvey Environmental Monitoring in Flooded Neighborhoods

Two weeks after Hurricane Harvey made historic landfall in Texas, resulting in extensive flooding in Houston and surrounding areas, SWCOEH launched an environmental monitoring campaign in heavily flooded neighborhoods including East Houston, Memorial, and Baytown. Our team is collecting soil and water samples which will be assessed for chemical and biological contaminants. The results will help us to better understand the impact of Harvey-related exposures on health following a hurricane characterized by unprecedented flooding.
